## **JITF SEEKING NEW INFORMATION ON JULY 31 KLOKOT BOMBINGS**

**CAMP BONDSTEEL, KOSOVO** – In a new development in the continuing investigation into the July 31 Klokot bombings, the Joint Investigative Task Force (JITF) is now looking for three specific vehicles that were seen in the area prior to the explosions.

The first vehicle was described as a green Mercedes cargo truck with a light blue canvas tarp over the box of the truck. The truck had Kosovo license plates, weighed approximately 2,200 kilograms, and had single rear wheels.

The second vehicle was described as a Jeep-style, sports utility vehicle. The vehicle was green and had FYROM license plates. An emblem of an unknown company was spotted on the front hood of the vehicle.

The third vehicle was described as a 1988 or 1989 yellow Nissan van, 4 x 4, with FYROM license plates. The plates had red lettering and the license number began with SK.

The JITF is requesting any information pertaining to the whereabouts of these three vehicles or their owners.

Citizens can pass information to any KFOR, KPS or UNCIVPOL representative. Citizens may also call the JITF Hotline at 02-80-24321. The JITF is still offering a 2500 Euro reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrators. Those wishing to do so will remain anonymous.
