### **LOCAL DOCTORS AND U.S. KFOR PROVIDE HEALTH CARE TO RESIDENTS OF CERNICA AND KLOKOT**

**CAMP BONDSTEEL, Kosovo** — U.S. KFOR medical personnel and local doctors provided free medical care to more than 300 residents during daylong clinics held in Cernica on March 28 and Klokot on March 30.

Medical personnel from the 2-2 Infantry Battalion at Camp Monteith worked with local Albanian and Serbian doctors from Donja Budriga and Zegra and their staffs to provide the medical services to approximately 160 residents in Cernica.

In addition to helping with local medical needs, the event encouraged all local residents to use the local clinic for their routine medical care.

“Both communities were well represented,” said 2nd Lt. Gregory McCrum, a physician’s assistant with the 2-2 Infantry Battalion. “I hope we have an even greater outpouring of support for future KFOR endeavors.”

In Klokot, U.S. KFOR soldiers from 2-63 Armor Battalion at Camp Magrath joined local medical professionals to see 123 patients for acute and chronic medical conditions over four hours.

Maj. John Press, an optometrist from Camp Bondsteel and Cpt. Brent Martin, a dentist from the 201<sup>st</sup> Field Support Group treated an additional 25 patients that day.

Participants enjoyed and benefited from the services offered in cooperation with Albanian, Serbian and U.S. KFOR medical personnel.
