MNB(E) detains two men for photographing KFOR installation

Camp Bondsteel, Kosovo – KFOR Multi-National Brigade (East) detained two men at about 11 p.m. Aug. 24, based on reports and evidence that the men had been photographing a KFOR installation.

KFOR soldiers had reported seeing one man photographing Camp Monteith at about 1 p.m. Aug. 23. The man drove away; the soldiers recorded the license plate number of the vehicle the man was driving.

Kosovo Police Service reported to Task Force 709th Military Police in Gnjilane that officers had seen the same car at about 1:30 p.m. Aug. 24 at a car wash in Malisevo. Soldiers of the 127th Military Police Company apprehended the driver at about 2:30 p.m., then conducted a search of multiple buildings belonging to the car's registered owner. The soldiers found evidence leading to possible surveillance of Camp Monteith and apprehended the second man at about 10:45 p.m.

Both men were taken to the Bondsteel Detention Facility.

MNB(E) conducted this action under the authority of United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244 and will continue to take prudent steps to ensure a safe and secure environment for all the people of Kosovo.
