**LOCAL DOCTORS AND KFOR CONDUCT
SUCCESSFUL MEDICAL CLINIC IN CERKEZ SADVINA**

CERKEZ SADVINA, Kosovo— Local doctors and the 2-63 Armor Battalion's Medical Platoon from Camp Magrath conducted their eighth medical clinic on Sunday, the first one held in the community of Cerkez Sadovina.

More than 150 patients, from the age of 3 to 87, received free medical, eye and dental screenings at the Cerkez elementary school.

This was the platoon's sixth medical exercise that included local health care providers. In the past six months, the 2-63 medical platoon has worked with local doctors and medical professionals to screen a total of 1,457 residents in Kosovo.

"I really enjoy doing these medical clinics, because it's always nice to get out and meet people," said Lt. Tyler Gence, 2-63 medical platoon leader. "They aren't all about medicine. The people who participate see people from all kinds of backgrounds all working together for the good of all the people in Kosovo."
